

Thinking of Immigrating to Canada?

Immigration laws are complex. While there are thousands of pages on the website of Citizenship and Immigration Canada, only a few may apply to you. So you need to find answers to your questions, and know how to apply the answers to your situation. In Canada, there are several categories under which individuals may apply for permanent residence.

- **Skilled Workers** – This category is for people who qualify under a point system based primarily on education and work experience
- **Provincial Nominee Class** – This category is for people with a specific skill or business which is in high demand for a particular Canadian province and who qualify under certain other legal requirements
- **Business Class** – This category is for people who qualify as entrepreneurs, investors, and self-employed persons
- **Family Class** – This category is for people who are immediate family members (i.e. common-law spouses, same sex spouses, spouses, unmarried dependent children, parents, grandparents, or siblings under 22 years of age and unmarried) of Canadian citizens or permanent residents
- **Canadian Experience Class** – This category is for people who have either completed two full years of work under a work permit in Canada *or* have studied full-time in Canada for two years, resulting in a degree or diploma, and have worked for a full year after that, in a professional, management or skilled area
- **Refugees** are accepted on the basis of Canada's commitment to protection of persecuted peoples pursuant to its obligations as a signatory to the United Nations Convention on Refugees
